FAMILY FUN IN THE VALLEY |

Bring the family for an adventure to Cumberland Valley Pennsylvania! Explore the interactive displays at the U.S. Army Heritage & Education Center, and get your heart pumping at the Carlisle Sports Emporium with laser

tag, mini-golf, batting cages, and indoor/outdoor go-kart tracks. Kids (and adults) will love to jump around the Skyzone Trampoline Park. After all of the exhilarating action, stop for a delicious sweet treat at one of the many ice cream parlors in the Valley. In the fall, pick your own pumpkins at farmer's markets and orchards, while gazing at the seasonal foliage.



NEED FOR SPEED |

Cruise into the Cumberland Valley for the famed Carlisle Events auto shows, where over 500,000 attendees come from across the world to admire new and classic vehicles at nine events, including the preeminent Corvette

show and parade. Pit stops along the way include Williams Grove Speedway and the Rolls Royce Museum.



UNCOVER HISTORY |

In between the tree-lined streets of historic downtown Carlisle is where you'll find history on display, including the story of Olympic athlete Jim Thorpe and the Carlisle Indian School at the Cumberland County Historical

Society. You'll also encounter the monument to the Revolutionary War heroine, Molly Pitcher. History buffs won't want to miss the artifacts and interactive exhibits at the U.S. Army Heritage & Education Center.



TAP, TOUR AND TRY A PINT |

The recently launched Cumberland Valley Beer Trail has 20+ stops with local craft favorites and hard-to-find imported gems. Sample the brews at the Revolutionary War themed Molly Pitcher Brewing Company and collect

stickers on your passport at destinations like Market Cross Pub & Brewery, Appalachian Brewing Company, and Al's of Hampden, which offers 100+ craft beer options.



EXPLORE OUTDOORS |

The Cumberland Valley offers hundreds of miles of trails in three state parks for the whole family to explore. Uncover the rolling hills and scenic landscape of the Valley while hiking, biking or horseback riding on the Cumberland

Valley Rail Trail, or enjoy the lakeside beach at Laurel Lake, where you can swim, kayak and boat. There's also 46 miles of the Appalachian Trail that meander through Cumberland Valley, including the midpoint of the entire trail. The Valley is also considered the home to fly-fishing with some of the world's most famed streams, and the Fly Fishing Museum.



DATE NIGHT |

Whether it's a week-long getaway, a weekend trip, or just a night without distractions, there's a romantic experience awaiting couples in the Valley. Taste flavors from around the world, with over 30 restaurants within in a few

short blocks of each other in downtown Carlisle. Couples can choose bed and breakfasts in quaint downtowns or cozy backwoods. The newly renovated Allenberry Resort provides couples with an opportunity for a dinner and a show, cocktails at the tavern, relaxation with spa services, and more.

The Cumberland Valley is the hub of Gettysburg, Hershey and Lancaster region with connections via Interstate 81, I-83, I-76 and US 11/15. 
