**DAYTONA BEACH SELECTED AS A TOP 10 DESTINATION:  
ConventionSouth “2015 Rising Destination for Meetings”**

**DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. (November 10, 2014)** – The Editors of *ConventionSouth* magazine, a national multimedia resource for planning events that are held within the South, have officially announced their 2015 list of the “Rising Destinations For Meetings.” This year, 10 destinations were selected to be on the list, including Daytona Beach, Florida.
