It’s only right to end lunch with a little something sweet, and an energy boost. Travel down Elizabeth Avenue to any one of our cultural bakeries...

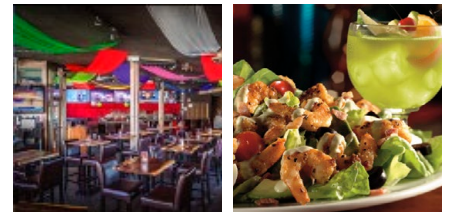
