


Introduction

- All data was collected by the Tattoo Convention staff during the event.
- Tattoo Convention management estimated **15,000** attendees prior to the event.
- There were **115** completed surveys.
- Using the 15,000 attendees, the Confidence Interval for this presentation with a 115 Sample Size is +/- 9.1%. Because of the size of the sample the Confidence Interval did not meet the "best practice" of +/- 5%.
