Introduction

- All data was collected by the All American Tattoo Convention staff during the event.
- The All American Tattoo Convention management estimated 5,000 attendees prior to the event.
- The actual number of attendees was 3,100 as reported by Jim Grafstrom, General Manager of the Crown Complex.
- The minimum number of completed surveys needed for a population of 3,100 is 342.
- The final number of completed surveys completed during the event was 214.
- Using the 3,100 attendees, the Confidence Interval for this presentation with a 214
 Sample Size is +/- 6.46%. Because of the size of the sample the Confidence Interval
 does not meet the "best practice" of +/- 5.00%.





- 6 of the 214 completed surveys provided an invalid zip code.
- 96 (45%) were from North Carolina.
- 117 (55%) were from more than 100 miles from Fayetteville.
- 88 (41%) identified themselves as being here specifically for the event and overnighting in a hotel.



Members of the armed forces and tattoos have a long history, which dates back to the beginning of the 20th century. For many service members, tattoos can serve as artistic reminders of friends they've made and lost along the way, or a symbol of pride for their service to our country. Fayetteville, NC 195 Southbound Exit 46B, Northbound Exit 40: It is no coincidence that this unique event is being held in Fayetteville, close to Fort Bragg, one of the largest military bases in the free world.

The goal of the **All American Tattoo Convention** is to give some of the best tattoo artists in the world the opportunity to showcase their talents to some of the bravest heroes in the world, all while raising money to assist soldiers with PTSD, and other combat related injuries, veterans and families of soldiers.

Bottom Line

- Not All Tourism Development Authority (TDA) requirements were met.
- 342 completed surveys would be needed for the attendance of 3,100 (214 were collected)
- 41% (88) of the completed surveys were overnighters and came specifically for the event.
- 9 participants were referred by their hotel.
- 26.63% were from Cumberland County, including Fort Bragg.
- 5.14% were day-trippers.
- Participants heard of the event mainly by Instagram(34.58%) and Word of Mouth (25.23%).
- 44 attendees signed up for the FACVB's E-Promotion Program.



Bottom Line Continued

- Room Nights Because the required sample size was below the TDA required amount, the FACVB was unable to accurately extrapolate room nights out to 3,100.
- The 88 who came for the event and stayed at a hotel, listed the following hotels:
