


Introduction

- All data was collected by the WIDU staff during the event.
- WIDU management estimated **24,000** attendees prior to the event.
- There were **2,572** completed surveys.
- Using the 24,000 attendees, the Confidence Interval for this presentation with a 2,572 Sample Size is +/- 1.83%. Because of the size of the sample the Confidence Interval exceeded the "best practice" of +/- 5%.





Bottom Line

- All Tourism Development Authority (TDA) requirements were met.
- **378** completed surveys was the agreed upon requirement (**2,572** collected)
- **136 (5.29%)** identified themselves as being here specifically for the event and overnighting in a hotel.
- 4 guests were here for another reason, but were referred by their hotel.
- 1,330 (51.71%) were from Cumberland County, including Fort Bragg.
- 835 (32.47%) were day-trippers.
- Participants heard of the event mainly from their Church (27.33%) and on Social Media (26.67%).
- **1,791** attendees signed up for the FACVB's E-Promotion Program and provided a valid E-mail address.



Bottom Line Continue

 For the calculations, the FACVB used the agreed upon estimated attendance number provided by WIDU management of 24,000. The sample size of 2,572 was considerably more than the required and agreed upon 378 completed surveys necessary to ensure the presentation met "best practices" of +/- 5%, as a result this presentation is at +/- 1.83%*.

*Because the surveys were opened up to the public to access the survey URL via WIDU to win a prize, there were instances of the same person completing multiple surveys (assuming to get more entries to win WUDU's prize giveaway). There were 298 duplicate completed surveys. Of the 298 duplicates, 21 were from people here for the event and staying at a hotel. This will slightly skew the numbers favorably.

- Of those participants staying at a hotel, the overall average length of stay was 2.27 nights.
- 5.29% of the participants (136) were overnighters and came specifically for the event extrapolated out to 24,000 participants this means potentially 1,269.6 people X 3 nights = 3,809 room nights (+/-1.83%)
