
Definite Bookings are up YTD and for the month due to staff's focus on closing & obtaining signed contracts and confirming numbers from Leisure groups.

Room nights are down due to two significant groups that did not rotate back to the Coast this year and smaller group bookings.



Leads Issued & Potential Room Nights






Pace Report - Pipeline





In Nov. 2017 we changed to a new provider (Meltwater), giving us accurate numbers within the digital platform, therefore 2018 figures can't be compared with previous year, as we are using a completely different reporting metric.




