OCEAN SPRINGS, MISS (WALA) - Gulf Islands National Seashore officials have completed all assessments and cleanup operations on the Mississippi islands, with the exception of West Ship Island.




Normal operations will resume on Cat, East Ship, Horn, West Petit
Bois (Sand), and Petit Bois Islands immediately. Ferry trips to West
Ship Island have been cancelled for the remainder of the season,
and the islands developed areas, boardwalks, restrooms, historic fort, and pier, are closed to all visitor use or access.


