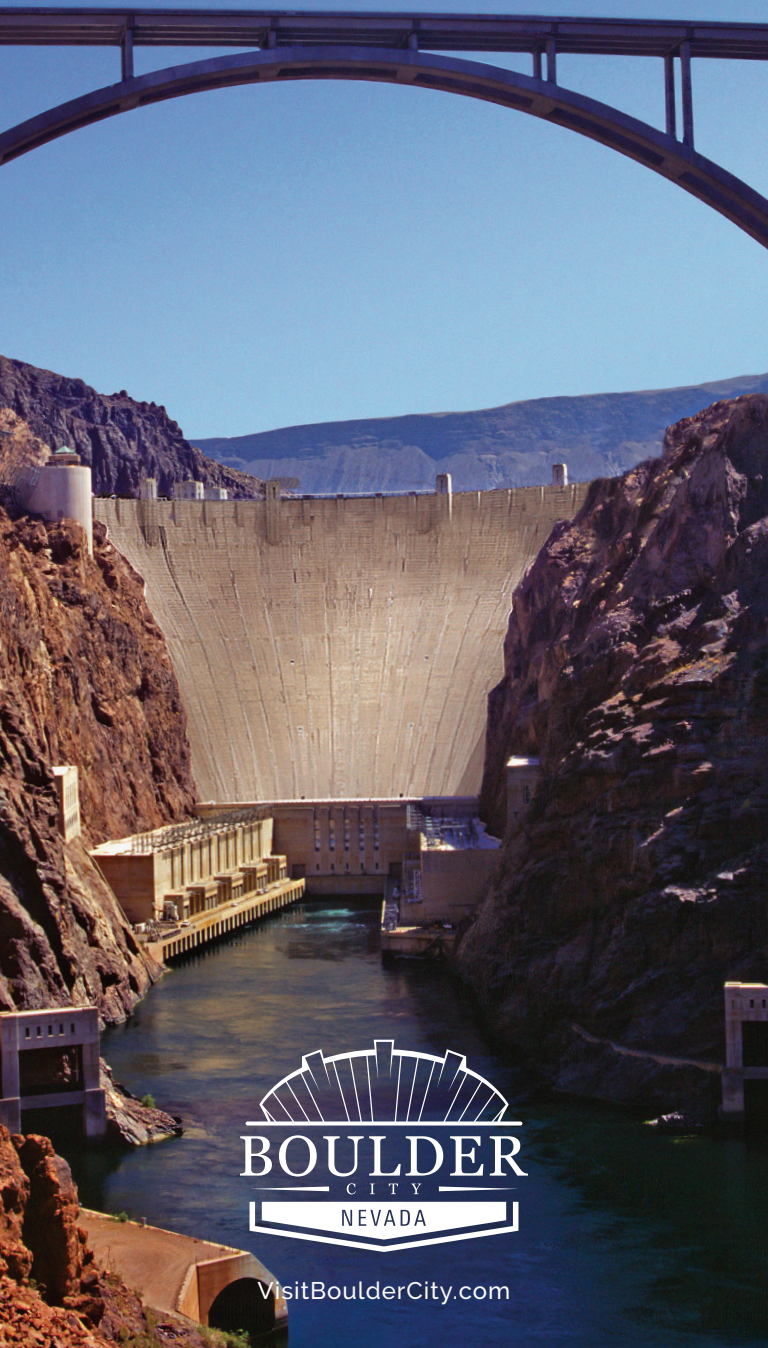

Take a tour of Hoover Dam every day except Thanksgiving and Christmas, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Or view the dam 840 feet above the Colorado River from the Mike O'Callaghan - Pat Tillman Memorial Bridge.

ACTIVITIES IN THE SKY

See iconic places like Hoover Dam, Lake Mead, Las Vegas Strip and the Grand Canyon from above in a one-hour or overnight helicopter or airplane tour. Or go tandem skydiving at Skydive Center. Fall from over two miles high at 120 mph, then slow to a scenic, peaceful five-minute parachute ride.

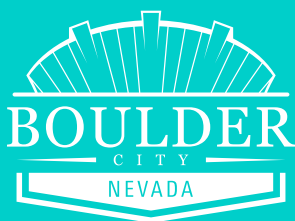
