

Travel trends

The popular countries that Indians travel to are its neighboring countries; Singapore, Thailand, Dubai (over 1 million to each of these countries) Europe & Long-haul travel: UK, Switzerland, France, USA and Canada (above approx. half million to each of these countries). Over 100.000 Indians travel to Italy, Spain, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa

SCANDINAVIA:

A typical round trip to Scandinavia comprises of Copenhagen, Oslo, Flåm, Bergen, Geirangerfjord, Stockholm. In recent years we have seen Stavanger and Tromso getting extremely popular.

Norway is often a country visited in between itineraries that begin in Stockholm or Copenhagen. Norway also happens to enjoy the longest stays of the 3 countries.

Some longer duration trips to Scandinavia have the option of adding Finland, Iceland and Russia.



Distribution network and trade patterns

- Travel Trade in India: A few big players and a lot of small to mid-size travel companies successfully influence end travelers. India continues to book over 80% of travel via online or offline travel companies. Even the online companies offer offline services and encourage office visits. This percentage of booking offline is even higher for Europe or the Scandinavian countries.
- A typical distribution network comprises of OTA's / Traditional travel companies / Wholesalers / wholesalers sourcing from Scandinavian DMC's / International consolidators.
