

# COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## SUMMARY

These terms and conditions apply to the competition to attend one of the Norwegian Supper Club events arranged by Innovation Norway in September/October 2022. Participants can sign up for a chance to win a seat at one (1) of the three (3) exclusive dinner events. The winners will be selected by a draw and contacted by Innovation Norway. The prize includes the dinner experience with food and drink during the event, it does not include travel to Norway and accommodation.

The prize includes the option to bring one (1) guest to the dinner. You can sign up for all three dinner events, but each participant can only win once - one dinner event. Each dinner event is one night only, and dates cannot be changed. If you cannot travel to location on your own expense, or if you cannot travel on the specified date - then your seat at the table will be forfeit. You must confirm your seat at least two weeks prior to the event.

The detailed terms and conditions are as follows:

### 1 DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 **"Competition"** means the Norwegian Supper Club competition outlined in clause 4;
- 1.2 **"Competition Period"** means from 13 June – 25 September 2022 CET 16:00.
- 1.3 **"Organizer"** means Innovation Norway (organization number 986 399 445), Akersgata 13, 0158 Oslo.
- 1.4 **"Participant"** means a participant fulfilling the requirements set out in clause 3;
- 1.5 **"Prize"** means the prize outlined in clause 4.4;
- 1.6 **"Territory"** means all countries in the world;
- 1.7 **"Ts&Cs"** means the competition terms and conditions set out in this document; and
- 1.8 **"Winner"** means a Participant winning a Prize.

### 2 GENERAL

- 2.1 The Competition is organized by the Organizer.
- 2.2 By entering the Competition, the Participants agree to be legally bound by these Ts&Cs.

### 3 PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 Participants must:
  - 3.1.1 be at least 21 years of age at the date of entry;
  - 3.1.2 The participant must be open and willing to enjoy most dietary menu options, as this is a meal of high and varied culinary excellency, and completely in the hands of the chefs – however, the participant must communicate any allergies or dietary restrictions upon accepting the prize.

**3.1.3 be a legal resident of the Territory;**

3.1.4 ensure that their participation in the Competition does not breach their obligations towards their employers or applicable laws;

3.1.5 register for the Competition on the Organizer's website (<http://visitnorway.com/things-to-do/supper-club>);

3.1.6 provide true and complete information when registering for the Competition pursuant to clause 3.1.4;

3.1.7 accept and comply with these Ts&Cs; and

3.1.8 not be an employee of the Organizer or a family member of such an employee.

3.2 It is the responsibility of the Participants to ensure they meet all requirements set out in clause 3.1. The Organizer reserves the right to verify the eligibility of any of the Participants by requesting documents proving that the Participants comply with the requirements.

3.3 If a Participant does not meet all requirements set out in clause 3.1, the Participant's submission will not be considered, and they will be excluded from winning a Prize in the Competition.

3.4 Obtaining time off work to participate in the Competition and/or take a Prize will be the sole and absolute responsibility of each Participant.

3.5 There is no purchase requirement to participate in the Competition. Thus, no financial contribution (payment of a wager, stake or similar) from the Participants is required by the Organizer

3.6 The Organizer will only send marketing communications to Participants which have provided their prior consent (i.e. "opt in").

**4 COMPETITION AND PRIZE DETAILS**

4.1 Participants join the Norwegian Supper Club competition by filling out a form on the Organizer's web page.

4.2 All fields in the form must be filled out correctly by the Participant within the Competition Period.

4.3 The Participant needs to meet all requirements set in clause 3 to participate.

4.4 The Prize contains of a full dining experience including food and drinks on one of the following dates and locations:

- 4.5 The Participants can sign up for all three dinner events, but each Participant can only win once (one dinner event).
- 4.6 The Prize includes the option to bring one (1) guest to the dinner. The guest must also accept and comply with these Ts&Cs. The guest will then get the dinner experience with food and drink during the event, but it does not include travel to Norway and accommodation.
- 4.7 The value of each Prize (each cover) is approximately NOK 15 000 including VAT.
- 4.8 The draws will be carried out by Innovation Norway and the draw will take place manually under supervision of an independent person.

## 5 NOTIFICATION TO WINNERS AND REQUIREMENTS

- 5.1 The Winners will be notified by email or telephone.
- 5.2 In the event that a Winner:
  - 5.2.1 does not accept the Prize at least two weeks prior to the event;
  - 5.2.2 rejects the Prize;
  - 5.2.3 cannot prove that it complies with the participation requirements set out in these Ts&Cs;
  - 5.2.4 refuses to comply with regulatory requirements in the Territory relating to the Competition and/or awarding of the Prize; or
  - 5.2.5 cannot provide proof of identity reasonably acceptable to the Organizer;

the Winner will lose its right to win the Prize and the Organizer may offer the Prize to another Participant.

- 5.3 Prizes may under no circumstances be exchanged, altered or compensated.
- 5.4 Any tax payable as a result of a Prize being awarded or received will be the responsibility of the Winners. The Winners should seek independent financial advice prior to accepting a Prize if this is a concern.
- 5.5 The Organizer has the right to publicise, broadcast and communicate to the public the names and home towns of the Winners. The Winners agree to take part in all reasonable Competition related publicity (such as interviews and photography) surrounding the winning of the Prize.

## **6    PRIVACY/DATA PROTECTION**

### **6.1    The Controller and applicable law**

6.1.1    The Organizer is the controller of the personal data to be processed in relation to the Competition.

6.1.2    The Organizer is established in Norway. Unless mandatory data protection legislation in the Territory dictates otherwise, the processing of personal data in relation to the Competition is subject to the Norwegian Personal Data Act and the General Data Protection Regulation

### **6.2    Data subjects**

6.2.1    Personal data relating to the following data subjects will be processed:

- Participants

### **6.3    Types of personal data processed**

6.3.1    The following personal data relating to the data subjects will be processed:

- First name
- Surname
- Mobile number
- Email address
- Country of residence

### **6.4    Processing purposes**

6.4.1    The Organizer will process the personal data for the following purposes:

- To administer the Competition.
- To exercise its rights and fulfil its obligations pursuant to the Ts&Cs.
- To comply with legal obligations.
- To send marketing communications per email to the Participants who has consented to receiving such communications.

### **6.5    Other**

6.5.1    The Organizer will not disclose the Participants' personal data to third parties (acting as controllers) unless such disclosure is necessary to fulfill its contractual obligations pursuant to the Ts&Cs or to comply with legal obligations. The Organizer does not allow any third party to use the personal data for marketing or communication purposes. For the avoidance of doubt, the Organizer may use third parties (acting as processors) to process personal data on behalf of the Organizer (e.g. in relation to hosting etc).

- 6.5.2 The Organizer shall not store the personal data longer than is necessary to carry out the purpose of the processing unless the Organizer is legally obligated to store the personal data for a longer period (e.g. pursuant to archiving legislation).

## **7 LIABILITY**

- 7.1 To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Organizer hereby exclude and shall not have any liability to any Participant or Winner in connection with or arising out of the Competition howsoever caused, including for any costs, expenses, forfeited Prizes, damages and other liabilities.
- 7.2 The Organizer is not responsible for submissions that are incomplete, confusing or do not reach their destination due to any technical or human error, including, among other things, any kind of malfunctioning electronic devices.
- 7.3 The Organizer makes no representation or warranty in relation to Prizes provided and to the fullest extent permitted by law the Organizer shall have no liability to the Winners in relation to any Prize, its fitness for purposes, merchantability or otherwise.
- 7.4 The Participants shall indemnify and hold the Organizer harmless against any claims, actions, demands and procedures, including those issued by third parties, against any damages, losses, costs, expenses, fees, penalties and responsibilities (including but not limited to attorneys' and solicitors' costs and fees) that occur during the Competition as a result of any of the Participant's breach of these Ts&Cs.
- 7.5 In the event that any provision of these Ts&Cs is held to be illegal, invalid, void or otherwise unenforceable, it shall be severed from the remaining provisions which shall continue in full force and effect.

## **8 TAMPERING, TERMINATION AND CHANGES**

- 8.1 If for any reason the Competition is not capable of running as planned as a result of any (including but not limited to) technical failures, unauthorised intervention, computer virus, mobile network failure, tampering, fraud or any other causes beyond the Organizer's control which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Competition, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition and/or to disqualify any Participant who (whether directly or indirectly) causes (or has caused) the problem.
- 8.2 The Organizer may vary the Ts&Cs or terminate the Competition at any time at its absolute discretion without liability to any Participant or other person. The Organizer will not award a Prize if the Competition is terminated.

## **9 GOVERNING LAW AND LEGAL VENUE**

- 9.1 Unless mandatory legislation in the Participant's Territory dictates otherwise, the Participant and the Organizer agree that:

9.1.1 these Ts&Cs are governed by Norwegian laws; and

9.1.2 the district court in Oslo shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with the TS&Cs and/or the Competition.
