### Perryville Recreation Path

Argus Dr. & Perryville Rd.  
(Rockford)

Hop on this 14.9 mile path which is built through the Keeling-Puri Peace Plaza and connects to the 1.4 mile loop at Midway Village.

### Rock River Recreation Path

Davis Park to Mercyhealth  
Sportscore One  
(Rockford & Loves Park)

Built at the bicentennial community project in 1976, this ten mile paved path winds along the Rock River and beside Sinnissippi Gardens.

### Stone Bridge Trail

Stone Bridge and Roland  
Olson Forest Preserves  
(Roscoe)

Built on a former rail bed dating back to the 1850s, this path provides a crushed limestone pathway through rural countryside.
