Kent Hojem started working at the Puyallup Fair + Events Center in 1996 and became the CEO in 2005. The Puyallup Fair is the eighth largest fair in the world, spanning 17 days and featuring more than 15,000 attractions. Kent is responsible for the operation of the fair and event center 365 days a year. He takes care of everything that goes on at the fair in every way, shape and form.

In 2011, travelers to Puyallup spent \$89.2 million and generated \$6.8 million in state and local tax revenues, creating 1,000 jobs with \$22.3 million in earnings.
